For sixteen years, the Builders Association of North Central Florida (BANCF) has awarded to a past leader the **A.W. Fletcher Service Award** in honor of A.W. Fletcher who was instrumental in guiding the association from the beginning, and continued to play a vital role in both the organization and the community for close to 50 years.

Each year, the award is presented to a past BANCF President who rendered the most outstanding service to the Association during the previous year. This year's recipient, **Jack Greer**, Robinshore, Inc. was President of the organization in 2000. In presenting the award, BANCF President Adam Bolton said, "It's been nine years since Jack was President but he continues to get things done for the Association. In light of current economic conditions, the annual Parade of Homes had to undergo critical decisions and creative ideas. He took on this complicated BANCF project and made it a huge success. We thank Jack for all his efforts."

The Builders Association also established an award to be presented annually to a past Associate Vice-President who rendered the most outstanding service to the association during the previous year. It is named the **Don Lester Service Award** after a man who served and worked for the Association for many years. This year's recipient of the Don Lester Service Award, **Jay Brown**, Brown & Cullen, was the 2006 Associate Vice President. During the award presentation, Bolton remarked, "Jay dedicates much of his time and expertise to work on complex and difficult issues on behalf of all BANCF members. Many times his efforts are behind the scenes, advocating compromises on regulations that would increase housing costs in our community. He also chaired the GRU Committee working on several critical issues this past year."

The awards were presented at the May 21st Builders Association Membership meeting and each recipient received an engraved Silver Cup, a replica of the original ones presented to A.W. Fletcher and Don Lester.
